### *Directions to Moot*

*Moot is at Karamu Trail Track, 37  
Smith Road, Karamu 3285*

From the north:  
Turn right onto State Highway 39  
At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit and stay on State Highway 39  
Turn right onto State Highway 23  
Take the 1st left onto Te Pahu Rd  
Turn right onto Smith Rd  
Follow Moot Signs from here

From the south  
From Otorohanga  
Head west on State Highway 31/State Highway 39 towards Lawrence St  
Continue to follow States Highway 39  
Turn left into Te Pahu Rd  
Turn left onto Smith Rd  
Follow Moot Signs from here

**Lake Adventures** – swimming togs, towel, walking  
shoes, sunscreen, hat, wallet

**Pamper Tour** – comfortable clothes to dance in  
(singlets and tights, burlesque dresses – your choice  
– heels if you really want), wallet.

**The Golden Mile** – Valid form of ID, wallet

**Tough Person Caving** – old clothes eg overalls,  
closed in shoes eg gumboots or sneakers, personal  
medication if required

**Up in the Air** – socks, walking shoes
